What is expected: Develop a strategy I

- What is the main objective of your strategy?
- What is the context of and rationale for your strategy, and what are your key arguments?
- What method would you use to realise your strategy?
- Who are your allies/enemies among EU, non/member-state actors, institutions and other actors?
- How to implement your strategy? What are your priorities?
 - Consider means for influencing relevant policies
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What is expected: Develop a strategy II

1. An outline of what you see to be the main challenges to EU politics and governance (today/ in 2016)
2. Clear ideas of what maybe the relevant solutions to these challenges
3. 3 bullet points about the main objective of the group's strategy
4. 3 bullet points about individual members' perspectives

What is expected: Develop a strategy III

In two weeks' time (12 December 2016):

1. Final strategy presentation of 25 mins.
 1. Expand on what EU challenges are
 2. Identify political/ governance routes to resolve these challenges from the point of view of your actor *and* your organisation
 3. Each person to introduce their own personal approach and contribution to the strategy
 4. At least one member of the group to represent organisation (also)
 5. Strategy leaflet: Prepare a leaflet around your strategy and call to mobilise the public around your objective
