- 1. "The development of the European Community was founded on a bargain struck between France and West Germany in which France would provide the political lead and Germany the economic clout." To what extent to do you agree with this statement?
 - a. Do you think member states (not only these two) have similarly divers role in the policy-making of today's European Union?
 Consider in light of integration theories provided by Haas,
 Morvacsik and Bickerton.
- To what extent do you find 'Euroepeanisation' useful in explaining the changes that has occurred in Europe since the 1950s? Give examples for and against this approach.
- How has the EU affected the domestic political realm and, especially, party politics? Compare three member states and the main/governing parties.
- 4. How has 'Europeanisation' affected inter-state relationships in Europe and the EU? Consider both the relationship between/within member states and European states (non-member states).
- Is enlargement necessary for the survival of the European Union "project"? Debate.
